RESOLUTION #2020-35

Public Works Project No. 80-260, 80-270, 80-280, & 80-290

IN THE MATTER OF AUTHORIZING RIGHT OF WAY AND EASEMENT ACQUISITION FOR THE REPAIR OF VARIOUS LEVEES RESULTING FROM THE 2020 FLOOD EVENT.

WHEREAS: Columbia County budgeted funding for assistance in the repair of associated levees from the 2020 flood event; and,

WHEREAS Columbia County will receive funding from FEMA, and/or the Department of Ecology as a result of the emergency declaration; and,

WHEREAS: that the repair of the flood control infrastructure is a top priority with the Board of County Commissioners which will allocate matching funds as necessary; and,

WHEREAS: that the Board of County Commissioners adopted Resolution 2020-31 approving the rehabilitation of the Levee system and authorized the County Engineer to administer the project; and

WHEREAS: that the repair of the flood control infrastructure requires additional right of way and easements to complete.


IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, that Board of County Commissioners authorizes the Chairman to execute Right of way deeds and Temporary Construction Easements required for the successful competition of the levee Rehabilitation Projects; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Board of County Commissioners authorizes the County Engineer to negotiate and execute agreements for acquisition of right of way and temporary construction easements on behalf of Columbia county; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners authorizes the County Engineer to administer any agreements for this work on behalf of Columbia County.


