RESOLUTION #2020-42

IN THE MATTER OF AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF STARBUCK AN EASEMENT OVER A PORTION OF COUNTY PROPERTY FOR THE REPAIR OF THE STARBUCK LEVEE RESULTING FROM THE 2020 FLOOD EVENT.

WHEREAS: The Town of Starbuck has need of a Temporary Construction Easements for the repair of the Starbuck levee from the 2020 flood event; and,

WHEREAS Columbia County has a parcel of land located adjacent to the Starbuck Bridge that includes a portion of the existing levee; and,


WHEREAS: that the Starbuck Levee Rehabilitation project by the Corps of Engineers requires access across the County property; and,

WHEREAS: that the Town of Starbuck has requested an easement across the County property to accommodate the Corps project.




