

RESOLUTION #2019-31

BEFORE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF COLUMBIA COUNTY

In the Matter of the restriction on certain county roads to maximum axel weight.

Notice is hereby given that pursuant to the provisions of RCW 36.75.270 and RCW 46.44.080, the listed Columbia County Roads are hereby restricted to travel of all vehicles exceeding the weight as listed herein for a period of 400 days from the date of this resolution. **EXCEPT**, this order shall be in affect only when an appropriate notice is posted at the termini of each restricted road or section thereof; and, by general rule, school buses and emergency vehicles are authorized operation in accordance with weight and speed restrictions as may be established by the County Engineer. Special permits for vehicles transporting perishable commodities or commodities necessary for the health and welfare of local residents, under such weight and speed restriction as deemed necessary, may be obtained at the Office of the County Engineer.


1. **THIS ORDER** shall supersede for the period designated, any previous order in conflict herewith, provided that this order shall not supersede or modify any restrictions now in force covering load limits on bridges located upon any county road.

The following county roads designated are closed to all vehicles, the gross weight (vehicles and load) of which exceeds the following load limits:


Eckler Mountain Road (Rd. No. 91240) – Axel Weight Limit 4 Tons
Hartsock Grade (Rd. No. 91310) – No Trucks over 7000 lbs Empty
Hatley Gulch Road (Rd. No. 14240) – Axel Weight Limit 4 Tons
Robinette Mountain Road (Rd. No. 13370) – Axel Weight Limit 4 Tons

2. **NO ALLOWANCE SHALL BE MADE** for any second axle suspended from the frame or the vehicles independent of the regular driving axle, otherwise known as “rigid trail” axles. Allowance will be made for single tires only on the front axle of any truck. The load distribution on any one axle of a vehicle shall be such that it will not load the tires on said axle in excess of the prescribed load, as above set forth. Any loading in excess of the specified maximums as listed herein will be considered a violation of this order. If the motive power for any type of trailer is inadequate to safely handle the specified maximum load as listed herein for such trailer then, in that event, the load on the trailer shall be reduced sufficiently to allow said truck and trailer to operate with safety.
3. **VIOLATING - MISDEMEANOR. VIOLATION-MISDEMEANOR** – As passed by Ordinance No. 2003-03, violations of any resolution by the Columbia County Board of Commissioners closing a county road, or limiting the classes or types of vehicles allowed on any county road or bridge enacted in compliance with RCW Title 36, shall be punishable as Criminal Trespass in the Second Degree, as designated in the Criminal Code RCW 9A.52.080.




