RESOLUTION #2019 - 42

IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING THE PRELIMINARY DESIGN OF THE STARBUCK BRIDGE REPLACEMENT AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY ENGINEER TO PROCEED WITH FINAL DESIGN AND PREPARTION FOR RIGHT-OF-WAY ACQUISITION.

WHEREAS, this project was approved by the Board of County Commissioners on January 16, 2013 by Resolution 2013-02 and the project is priority number 3 on the Columbia County Six Year Transportation Improvement Program from 2019 to 2024 adopted as amended on December 19, 2018 by Resolution #2018-56; and


WHEREAS, the project lies within the Town of Starbuck's existing urban growth area (UGA) where Columbia County held an Open House on October 21, 2017 for the citizens of Starbuck to provide feedback and input on the bridge replacement options and Option 2 was selected as the most desirable by the Citizens of Starbuck and has been identified as the preferred alignment by the City Council of the Town of Starbuck; and

WHEREAS, The Town of Starbuck City Council declared their support for Option 2, with Resolution 2019-05 on August 27, 2019.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Columbia County Board of Commissioners hereby approves the design alignment supported by the Town of Starbuck and authorizes the County Engineer to finalize design and prepare all right-of-way acquisition materials required for construction.


