RESOLUTION #2019 - 48

IN THE MATTER OF FORM OF REIMBURSEMENT FOR THE PURCHASE AND REMODEL OF 112 NORTH SECOND STREET, DAYTON, WASHINGTON

WHEREAS, Columbia County, Washington (the "Local Agency") reasonably expects to reimburse the expenditures described herein with the proceeds of a financing contract to be entered into by the Local Agency (the "Reimbursement Obligation"); and

WHEREAS, The expenditures with respect to which the Local Agency reasonably expects to be reimbursed from the proceeds of Reimbursement Obligations are for the purchase and remodel of 112 North Second Street, Dayton, WA 99328 to be used as the County Public Health Facility; and

WHEREAS, The expenditures with respect to which the Local Agency reasonably expects to be reimbursed from the proceeds of reimbursement obligations will be made from the Capital Improvement Fund; and

WHEREAS, the maximum principal amount of reimbursement obligations expected to be issued for the property described in Section 2 is \$272,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that Board of Columbia County Commissioners do authorize the reimbursement obligation for the purchase and remodel of 112 North Second Street, Dayton WA 99328.


