BEFORE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF COLUMBIA COUNTY

In the Matter of a Project to Improve Ventilation at the Transfer Station

WHEREAS Columbia County owns and operates a solid waste transfer station; and,

WHEREAS the transfer station was rebuilt in 2017 after the previous transfer station was damaged by fire. The new transfer station is approximately twice the size of the previous transfer station; and,

WHEREAS the prevailing winds do not ventilate the new transfer station. This causes a health issue to the public and county employee's from the dust and debris that hangs in the air; and,

WHEREAS the Public Works Director recommends installing new fans in the transfer station and a positive pressure heating/cooling system in the weigh shack to address this problem; and,

WHEREAS the project is listed in the 2018 – 2020 Capital Improvement Program; and,

WHEREAS RCW 82.46.010 authorizes taxes collected on the sale of real property to be used for capital projects including the repair of administrative facilities.


IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that the Public Works Director is authorized to utilize County forces and/or solicit bids and award a contract through the small works roster for the following; and,

Install ventilation fans and a heating/cooling system in the weigh shack. The estimated cost of the project is \$15,000.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this work shall be funded by Fund #104 – County Capital Improvement; and,
