BEFORE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF COLUMBIA COUNTY

In the Matter of a Project to Install a Heating Ventilation Air Conditioning (HVAC) System at the Fairgrounds Pavilion

WHEREAS the County owns a building commonly known as the Pavilion at the County Fairgrounds; and

WHEREAS the County has received a grant from the Washington State Department of Agriculture in the amount of \$54,000 to assist in the cost of installing insulation and an HVAC system at the Pavilion; and,

WHEREAS the Columbia Rural Electric Association has pledged \$10,000 to assist in the cost of the project; and,

WHEREAS the Commissioners desire to install insulation and an HVAC system at the Pavilion.

WHEREAS RCW 82.14.370 authorizes sales and use tax for public facilities in rural counties to be used to finance public facilities serving economic development purposes; and

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that the Public Works Director is authorized to utilize County forces and/or solicit bids and award a contract through the small works roster for the following; and,

Install an HVAC system and insulate the Pavilion. Work includes, at a minimum, insulation, heat pump, ductwork and electrical work. The estimated cost of the project is \$75,000.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this project shall be funded by Fund #108 – Rural Excise Sales Tax for any costs over and above the grant funds and donations; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the 2016 - 2018 Capital Improvement Plan is amended to add this project to the plan.
