BEFORE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF COLUMBIA COUNTY

In the Matter of a Project to Remodel a Public Works Storage Building

WHEREAS the County is acquiring property from the Seneca Corporation commonly known as the softball field and the trailer pad site and is adjacent to the County's public works campus; and

WHEREAS the property has a masonry building that used to house a laundromat; and,

WHEREAS the Commissioners desire to remodel the building for use as a storage building for public works document storage; and,

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that the Public Works Director is authorized to utilize County forces and/or solicit bids and award a contract through the small works roster for the following; and,

Remodel the laundromat building on the former Seneca property to allow the building to be used for document storage. Work will include, at a minimum, sealing off holes in the masonry walls where the driers vented, replace the doors and windows, remove interior walls, remove the interior plumbing and sewer service, and upgrade the wiring and lighting. The estimated cost of the project is \$7,500.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the work to install fencing and gates for the remainder of the property shall be funded by Fund #101 – County Road




