**RESOLUTION #2021 – 18**

**IN THE MATTER OF AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND COLUMBIA COUNTY TO RECEIVE ER FUNDS FOR THE REPAIR OF BOSLEY BRIDGE DAMAGED DURING THE 2020 FLOOD EVENT.**

**WHEREAS**, Columbia County has received funding from the Washington State Department of Transportation in the amount of \$318,200 for repairs to Bosley Bridge on Tucannon Road (Road No. 92330); and,

**WHEREAS**, The project is priority number 3 on the Columbia County Six Year Transportation Improvement Program from 2021 to 2026 adopted on December 7, 2020 by resolution 2020-61 and amended on May 3, 2021 by Resolution 2021-17.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED**, that the Board of County Commissioners hereby authorizes that improvements be made to Bosely Bridge on Tucannon Road (Road No. 82330) described as follows:

Design and construction of a segmented gravity block wall and riprap embankment protection within the damaged bank sections immediately upstream and downstream of the bridge wing walls. Estimated cost of such engineering and construction is approximately \$359,000.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Board of County Commissioners authorize the Chairman of the Board to execute the agreement with the State of Washington to obligate ER funds identified for Design and Construction of the Bosely Bridge Emergency Repair Project on behalf of Columbia County; and,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Board of County Commissioners authorize the County Engineer to administer the agreement on behalf of Columbia County in accordance with the adopted Certification Acceptance Qualification Agreement.


