RESOLUTION #2021 - 40

IN THE MATTER OF AUTHORIZING THE ACQUISITION OF REAL PROPERTY FOR THE PURPOSE OF AN AGGREGATE SOURCE AND STOCKPILE SITE FOR THE COUNTY ROAD DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the Washington Department of Transportation owns a Quarry in Columbia County on Willow Creek Road, has declared the property surplus and is offering it to Columbia County; and,

WHEREAS, The Board of County Commissioners desires to acquire real property for the purposes of constructing and maintain County roads; and,

WHEREAS, RCW 36.75.040 allows the Board of County Commissioners to acquire real property for county road purposes with or without cost,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman to execute an agreement with the Washington Department of Transportation to acquire the Willow Creek Quarry Site QS-CO-53 and stockpile site SP-CO-5405 for \$25,900 plus fees.
