RESOLUTION #2022 – 10

PWP 19-20 Kellogg Hollow Road (Phase 2) Project Survey

IN THE MATTER OF AWARDING A CONSULTANT CONTRACT TO PBS ENGINEERING AND ENVIRONMENTAL, INC. FOR SURVEYING SERVICES RELATED TO CIVIL ENGINEERING DESIGN, RIGHT-OF-WAY MAPPING AND CLOSEOUT.

WHEREAS, Columbia County Public Works has identified the PWP 19-20 Kellogg Hollow Road (Phase 2) Project which consist of improvements to the road as detailed within the authorization under Resolution 2019-27 and Resolution 2021-22; and,

WHEREAS, surveying services and deliverables provided by an licensed surveying consultant are necessary to perform and complete the design, right-of-way procurement, right-of-way mapping and closeout; and,

WHEREAS, the Public Works department followed the consultant selection process identified within the adopted Columbia County Procurement Policy, Section 6; and,

WHEREAS, four consults submitted proposals for consideration to provide surveying and right-of-way mapping services; and,

WHEREAS, PBS Engineering and Environmental, Inc. was found to be the most qualified to perform the work.


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that Board of County Commissioners authorizes the County Engineer to negotiate scope and fee as per 39.80.050 RCW and execute contracts with PBS Engineering and Environmental, Inc. for Surveying and Right-of-Way Mapping Services and Closeout, waive any irregularities, and authorize the County Engineer, or their designee, to administer the contract in accordance with the contract documents.

Should the County Engineer not be able to negotiate a scope and fee with PBS Engineering and Environmental, Inc. negotiations will be formally terminated and negotiations will begin with the second most qualified firm, Anderson Perry & Associates, Inc. Should negotiations with Anderson Perry & Associates, Inc. fail, they will be formally terminated and negotiations will begin with HMH Engineering. Should these negotiations fail, the process will be formally terminated in its entirety.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners authorize the County Engineer to administer the agreement on behalf of Columbia County.
