

**BEFORE THE BOARD OF COLUMBIA COUNTY COMMISSIONERS**

**RESOLUTION #2022-46**

**IN THE MATTER OF REGULATORY UPDATING AND CONTINUITY OF**

**FUND 122 SPECIAL PURPOSE PATHS AND TRAILS**

**WHEREAS**, RCW 47.30.050 requires Columbia County to expend, as authorized by RCW 46.68.090, in any fiscal year no less than 0.42 percent of the total amount of funds received from the Motor Vehicle Fund for the purposes required or permitted by RCW 47.30.030 on Special Purpose Paths and Trails.

**WHEREAS**, RCW 47.30.050 allows for the County, in lieu of expending these funds each year, to credit the funds to a financial reserve or special fund, to be held for not more than ten years and to be expended for the purposes required or permitted by RCW 47.30.030.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Columbia County, Washington, that the Columbia County Treasurer is directed to provide continuity to Fund 122 SPECIAL PURPOSE PATHS AND TRAILS FUND according to the above referenced RCWs and Commissioner's Resolution 87-1 for the purposes required or permitted by RCW 47.30.030; and, as prudent, to invest any balance of the fund on behalf of the SPECIAL PURPOSE PATHS AND TRAILS FUND.


