RESOLUTION #2022-50

**IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING A TRANSFER OF FUNDS
FROM 108 RURAL COUNTY EXCISE TO 104 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS**

WHEREAS, the County owns a building commonly known as the Pavilion, at the Columbia County Fairgrounds; and

WHEREAS, the Pavilion Restroom Improvement Project is a priority on the Columbia County Six Year Facility Capital Improvement Program from 2022-2027, adopted December 6, 2021 by Resolution 2021-57; and

WHEREAS, this facility is also part of the Cooperative Park Master Plan, adopted December, 2018; and the completed project will make the Pavilion Restrooms ADA accessible and have access from inside the Pavilion; and

WHEREAS, RCW 82.14.370 authorizes sales and use tax for public facilities in rural counties to be used to finance public facilities serving economic development purposes; and

WHEREAS, increase in project costs due to unprecedented inflation costs of building materials has created the need to transfer funds to cover these costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, this Board of Columbia County Commissioners, hereby authorizes a transfer of \$85,471 from Rural County Sales and Use Tax Fund 108 to Columbia County Capital Improvement Fund 104.


