BEFORE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF COLUMBIA COUNTY

In the Matter of the Authorizing an agreement between the Washington Department of Ecology and Columbia County to receive Grant funds for removal of debris associated with the 2020 Flood Event.

WHEREAS: Columbia County will receive funding from the Washington Department of Ecology in the amount of \$33,000 for assistance in debris removal from the 2020 flood event; and,

WHEREAS Columbia County will receive funding from FEMA, and/or the Corps of Engineers as a result of the emergency declaration; and,

WHEREAS: that the repair of the flood control infrastructure is a top priority with the Board of County Commissioners which will allocate matching funds as necessary.

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, acting as the Flood Control Zone District Board, that repairs to the public infrastructure be made as described:

Design and construction of repairs to drainage channels, levees and other flood control infrastructure. Estimated cost of such engineering and construction is approximately \$353,000.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Board of County Commissioners acting as the Flood Control Zone District Board authorizes the County Engineer to solicit for and execute agreements with the Granting agencies to receive grant funds identified for the Design and Construction of flood repair projects; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners acting as the Flood Control Zone District Board authorizes the County Engineer to administer any agreements for this work on behalf of Columbia County.
