**RESOLUTION #2019-27  
Public Works Project No. 19-20**

**In the Matter of the Authorizing an Agreement between the County Road Administration Board and Columbia County to Receive RATA funds for the Kellogg Hollow Road (Phase 2) Project.**

**WHEREAS:** Columbia County will receive funding from the County Road Administration Board in the amount of \$704,700 for the improvement of 1.9 miles of Kellogg Hollow Road (Road No 92250); and,

**WHEREAS:** This project is priority number 7 on the Columbia County Six Year Transportation Improvement Program from 2019 to 2024 adopted as amended on December 19, 2018 by Resolution #2018-56.

**IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS** that improvements be made to Kellogg Hollow Road (Phase 2) (Road No. 92250) described as follows:


Design and rehabilitate Road No. 92250 from MP 3.20 to MP 5.10. Work, at a minimum. Will consist of widening the existing road, replacing culverts, adding ballast, replacing guardrail, realigning the intersection with McKay-Alto Road, and asphalt concrete paving. Estimated Cost of such engineering and construction is approximately \$2,550,000.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** the Chairman of the Board is authorized to execute an agreement with the State of Washington County Road Administration Board to receive RATA funds identified for the Design and Construction of the Kellogg Hollow Road (Phase 2) Project; and,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Board of County Commissioners authorize the County Engineer to administer the agreement on behalf of Columbia County,


