RESOLUTION #2019 - 50

IN THE MATTER OF CORRECTING THE COUNTY ROAD LOG TO ESTABLISHED ROAD NAMES THAT REFLECTS PUBLIC KNOWLEDGE AND CURRENT SIGNAGE

WHEREAS, Public knowledge and Columbia County Public Works signage of the City of Dayton Cemetery road is Cemetery Road and the Town of Starbuck Cemetery road is Cemetery Hill Road ; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 97-02 accidently transposed the road names for the City of Dayton Cemetery as Cemetery Hill Road and the Town of Starbuck Cemetery road as Cemetery Road; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 97-02 was used to create the County Road Log which Ordinance 18-03 cited to be used for road identification for addressing pertaining to the enhanced 911 system.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the County Road Log be amended to reflect existing signage and public knowledge such that:


The road along the north of the City of Dayton Cemetery be named Cemetery Road.


