BEFORE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF COLUMBIA COUNTY

In the Matter of a Project to Replace the County Road Sand Shed

WHEREAS on January 24, 2018 structural damage to the current sand shed was discovered leading the County Engineer/Public Works Director to recommend replacement of the undersized, damaged and functionally obsolete building; and,

WHEREAS the Board of County Commissioners desires to replace the existing sand shed with a new structure capable of holding a two year supply of road sanding material; and,

WHEREAS the damaged sand shed has been tendered to the county's property insurance for coverage. However, the appraised value of the existing sand shed is less than estimated cost of the new building; and,

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that the Public Works Director is authorized to utilize County forces and/or solicit for the following; and,

Construct a new 60ft x 100ft sand shed. Work will include the design, bidding, site preparation, building construction and paving under the new sand shed. The estimated cost of the project is \$175,000.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this work not funded through insurance recovery shall be funded by Fund #101 – County Road.
