

RESOLUTION #2018-22

BEFORE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF COLUMBIA COUNTY

In the Matter of Delegating the Acting County Engineer Authority to Legally Bind the County for the Sole Purpose of Requesting Federal Reimbursement

WHEREAS: The County Engineer has been duly appointed by the Board of County Commissioners, and in accordance with RCW 36.80 to oversee and manage programs of the Public Works Department which includes the construction, alteration and maintenance of county roads; and,

WHEREAS: The Federal Highway Administration, through the State of Washington, makes federal transportation funding available to the county for road construction projects; and,

WHEREAS: The code of Federal Regulations, 2 CFR 200.415(a), has been revised to ensure that final fiscal reports or vouchers requesting payment under federal agreements must include a certification signed by an official who is authorized to legally bind the non-federal agency; and,


WHEREAS: The Board of County Commissioners executes all grant funding agreements and supplemental agreements, including federal grant agreements; and,


WHEREAS: In order to seek timely reimbursement for proper expenditures related to federally funded grant projects, the Board of County Commissioners desires to grant to the County Engineer, or their designee, authority to legally bind the county solely for the purpose of requesting federal grant reimbursement.

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that for the purposes of requesting reimbursement for federally funded road projects, the County Engineer, or their designee, shall be delegated authority, per 2 CFR 200.415(a), to legally bind the county in furtherance of the intent of this resolution; and,


