WHEREAS, the County has been dissatisfied with the environment and work product from SEWEDA; and


WHEREAS, the County's community partners agree that re-designation is in the best interest of the county; and

WHEREAS, Columbia County has its own economic development program that is working well and has the capacity to contract directly with the State of Washington.



PASSED AND ADOPTED by the Columbia County Board of Commissioners, State of Washington, on this 20th day of January, 2016.




