In the Matter of a Project to Replace the Roof of the Starbuck City Hall

WHEREAS the Town of Starbuck owns the building located at 200 Main St. in Starbuck, Washington and uses the building as the town hall; and

WHEREAS the roof of the town hall is damaged and nearing end of life; and,

WHEREAS the Commissioners desire to assist the Town of Starbuck with the replacement of the town hall roof; and,

WHEREAS the project is listed in the 2016 – 2018 Capital Improvement Program; and,

WHEREAS RCW 82.46.010 authorizes taxes collected on the sale of real property to be used for capital projects including the planning, repair, or replacement of recreational and administrative facilities.




Replace the roof of the Starbuck Town Hall. The estimated cost of the project is \$15,000.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this work shall be funded by Fund #104 – County Capital Improvement; and,
