BEFORE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF COLUMBIA COUNTY

In the Matter of a Project to Install Fencing and Gates on the Former Seneca Property

WHEREAS the County is acquiring property from the Seneca Corporation commonly known as the softball field and the trailer pad site and is adjacent to the County's public works campus; and

WHEREAS the property will be used to store various county road items as well be a secure impound area for the Sheriff's Office; and,

WHEREAS the Commissioners desire to install fencing and gates around the perimeter of the property as well as the Sheriff's Office impound area; and,

WHEREAS the project is listed in the 2016 – 2018 Capital Improvement Program; and,

WHEREAS RCW 82.46.010 authorizes taxes collected on the sale of real property to be used for capital projects including the planning, repair, or replacement of recreational and administrative facilities.

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that the Public Works Director is authorized to utilize County forces and/or solicit bids and award a contract through the small works roster for the following; and,


Install approximately 1,750 feet of fencing and three gates around the former Seneca softball field and trailer pad site. The estimated cost of the project is \$37,500.




BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the work to install fencing and gates for the remainder of the property shall be funded by Fund #501 – Equipment Rental and Revolving
