RESOLUTION #2021 - 61

IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING THE AWARD OF A CONTRACT FOR THE 2022-2025 FUEL SUPPLY CONTRACT TO VALLEY WIDE COOPERATIVE AND COLEMAN OIL COMPANY, LLC.

WHEREAS, Columbia County Public Works has identified the need to award a fuel contract for the 2022 through 2025 fiscal years; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works department followed the competitive process identified within the adopted Columbia County Procurement Policy, Section 5; and

WHEREAS, two contractors submitted proposals for consideration for four classifications of fuel utilized by the County; and

WHEREAS, Valley Wide Cooperative was the lowest and most responsive and responsible bidder on three of the classifications and Coleman Oil was the lowest and most responsive bidder on the fourth classification of fuel.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners authorizes the County Engineer to execute a contracts by low bid within the appropriate fuel class with Valley Wide Cooperative and Coleman Oil Company LLC, for the 2022 through 2025 Columbia County Fuel Contract, waive any irregularities, and authorize the County Engineer, or their designee, to administer the contract in accordance with the contract documents; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners authorizes multiple contracts for the purpose of only those vehicles that utilize both fuel types 1A and 1B to simplify fueling procedures and in the case of emergency.
