In the Matter of the Starbuck Yard Waste Facility

WHEREAS the Board of County Commissioners desires to construct a facility for the residents of Starbuck to place their yard waste for future disposal; and

WHEREAS the project is listed in the 2012 – 2017 Capital Improvement Program; and,

WHEREAS the Washington State Department of Ecology has awarded Columbia County a grant to pay 75% of the cost of this project with a not-to-exceed amount of \$14,475; and,


WHEREAS RCW 82.46.010 authorizes taxes collected on the sale of real property to be used for capital projects including the planning, repair, or replacement of recreational and administrative facilities.


IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS that the Public Works Director is authorized to utilize County forces or solicit bids and award a contract through the small works roster for the following; and,


Construct a gravel pad and place concrete ecology blocks for the purpose of storing yard waste. The estimated cost of the project is \$19,475.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this project shall be funded the Department of Ecology grant and by Fund #104 – County Capital Improvement.
